Prom Information 2011

Dear Parents:

This information form will provide you with specifics regarding Crespi Prom 2011, as well as reacquaint you with school policies and positions on several areas of concern.

Our Prom 2011 is scheduled for Friday, April 15, 2011, beginning at 8:00PM. The site of the Prom is the “**Fantasea Yacht in Marina Del Rey**”. The cost of the bid is \$160 per couple and includes dinner and dancing. The check is payable to Crespi Carmelite High School. ***Please note the fee is non-refundable.*** Formal attire is required, tuxedo or suit and tie for the gentlemen and suitable attire for the ladies. Please be sure your guest understands our appropriate dress requirements!!

* The signed permission slip and payment must be turned in to Mrs. Long **no later than Wednesday, April 6, 2011.** No bids will be accepted after this date!

Students must arrive at The Marina no later than 7:45PM. Boarding begins at 7:30PM. Students are required to be in attendance until 12:00AM. No one will be allowed to leave before midnight. If couples do not arrive by 8:00PM, they will not be able to board the boat and parents will be notified.

In some years past we have experienced a few difficulties at the Prom involving our students and the use of alcohol and/or narcotics. We feel a responsibility here to reiterate the fact that the Prom is a school sponsored event and as such our students are expected to adhere to all guidelines set forth in our Parent/Student Handbook. Our handbook states:

*It is the school's policy that the possession of, use of, giving of, being in the facility of or selling of alcohol or drugs on campus or at **any school-related activity** at any time is a serious matter, and the students will be subject to expulsion from school. Being under the influence of any type of alcoholic beverage or illegal drug on campus or **any school-related activity** makes the student immediately liable to dismissal from Crespi Carmelite High School. Alcohol or other drugs in a vehicle in the parking lot or in a school locker will be confiscated and is considered equal to “possession of alcohol or drugs”*

Any student who violates this or any other of our codes will have his parents called and the boat will be forced to dock so they can pick up their son. Your son will also face further disciplinary action.

In addition, we require the names and phone numbers of the parents of your son's date, as we will follow the same procedure if she is in violation of these codes. In the past, problems such as the ones described, have been the direct result of Pre and Post Prom unsupervised parties at which liquor was served freely. We also find mixed parties held at hotels after Prom very unacceptable. Unfortunately, we have been forced, in the past, to dismiss students with a month left before graduation as a result of this behavior at the Prom.

It has been our experience that even one problem of this nature casts a shadow over the entire evening and takes away from the enjoyment of all involved. Please help us to avoid this by having a frank and candid discussion with your son about these issues before Prom. It is our fervent hope that any incidents can be avoided and an enjoyable experience can be insured for all. We ask that you sign the confirmation form as an indication of your knowledge and support of our Prom policies.
