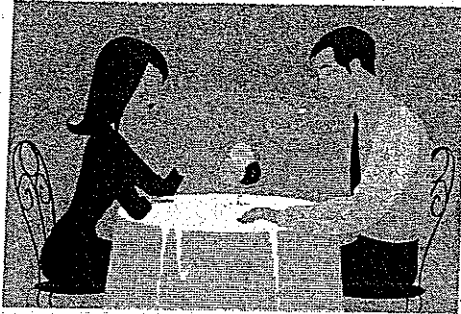


Crespi Frosh Box Social

Students will be given a sign-up sheet to coordinate the meal within their desired group of 5 classmates. This must be completed & returned to Mrs. Long in Activities asap & no later than Monday, Aug.22.

Please keep in mind the guests are not big eaters- a "lite meal" is best (salads, small sandwiches, pasta, etc.—no Lunchables or Happy Meals!). ALL food must be prepared & ready to eat- there are no facilities for heating or cooking! Pre-chilled individual drinks are easiest-NO liter bottles please!! Try to keep the food to a minimum as all uneaten food will be thrown out. Keep it simple!!! If you are sending items that need to be taken home- send a box, bag or container (w/name) to pack items in. The evening concludes with dancing. Please be here at 9PM to pick up your son. **ALL students are expected to attend this event!!** Our goal is to connect these two classes to meet and make friends as they spend the next four years together.
