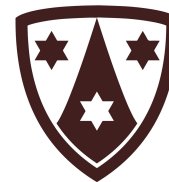


Crespi Summer School

Language Arts and The Crespi Man (Morning or Late Morning)
Integrated Math (Morning or Late Morning)

Language Arts and The Crespi Man (aka English)

This course reviews the conventions of English grammar and composition, and students apply those skills to reading and interpreting literature. Students who complete this course will be equipped with the foundations of the writing skills necessary for success in high school. Furthermore, this class will focus on a variety of study skills that will ease the transition to a demanding high school schedule. Extra emphasis will be placed on familiarity with Crespi's practices and policies as well as the faculty and campus to help alleviate non-academics anxiety that can build in advance of the first day of high school.

Integrated Math (aka Math)

Designed for students who are seeking extra practice of the basic math skills necessary for success in high school, this course allows students to stay fresh on the content they've mastered coming out of eighth grade. Also, this class introduces students to the rich blend of traditional and innovative instructional practices they'll experience at Crespi. Students will interact with Pre-Algebra, Algebra, and Geometry basics with pencil and paper as well through interactive online learning modules.
